



As small as a credit card, this AP incorporates an integrated antenna, an integrated IEEE 802.11g MAC/baseband, and USB host/device functions enabling manufacturers to build highly functional and low-cost Wi-Fi® access points.

The production-ready BCM94712 reference design includes the richest set of software features in the industry and 100% software compatibility with the AirForce product family. The turnkey, customizable software is code compatible with the BCM4702 and BCM4704 devices allowing OEMs to quickly migrate proprietary features built into IEEE 802.11a/b/g access points and routers into the BCM94712. Software features include advanced security protocols such as WPA, WPA2, TKIP, WEP, IEEE 802.11i, and IEEE 802.1x; browser-based network management tools, and the ability to simultaneously run WDS (wireless distribution system), Ethernet, and client functions.

Broadcom's superior technology and innovation benefit manufacturers with faster time-to-market, lower system costs, and end products that are differentiated from the competition through rich features and exceptional range and reliability. SmartRadioTM technology in the BCM2050 radio chip gives this product superior multipath performance, greater range and reliability, and tolerance to harsh system environments such as airports and other public access sites.
