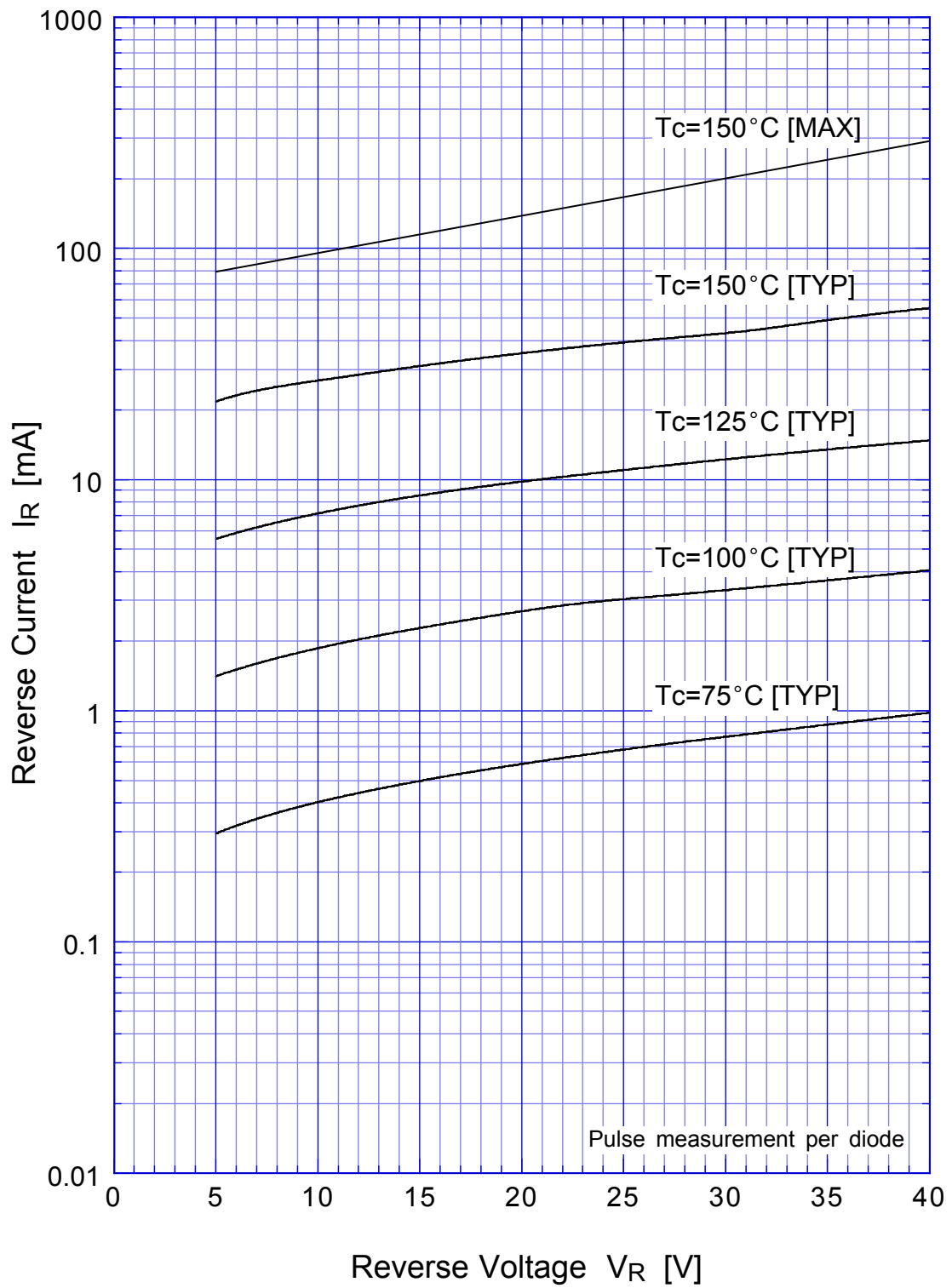

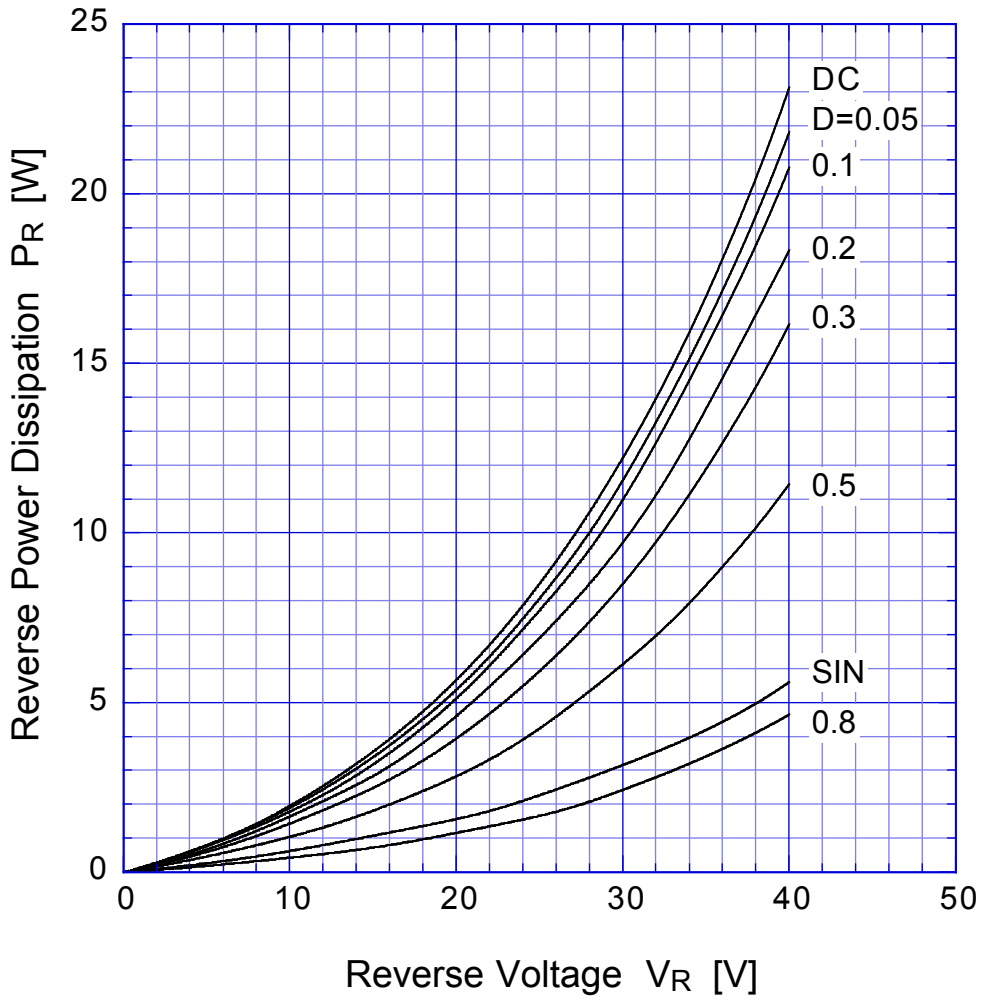
S15SCA4M Junction Capacitance



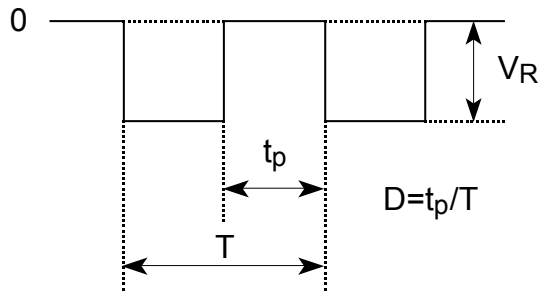
S15SCA4M Reverse Current



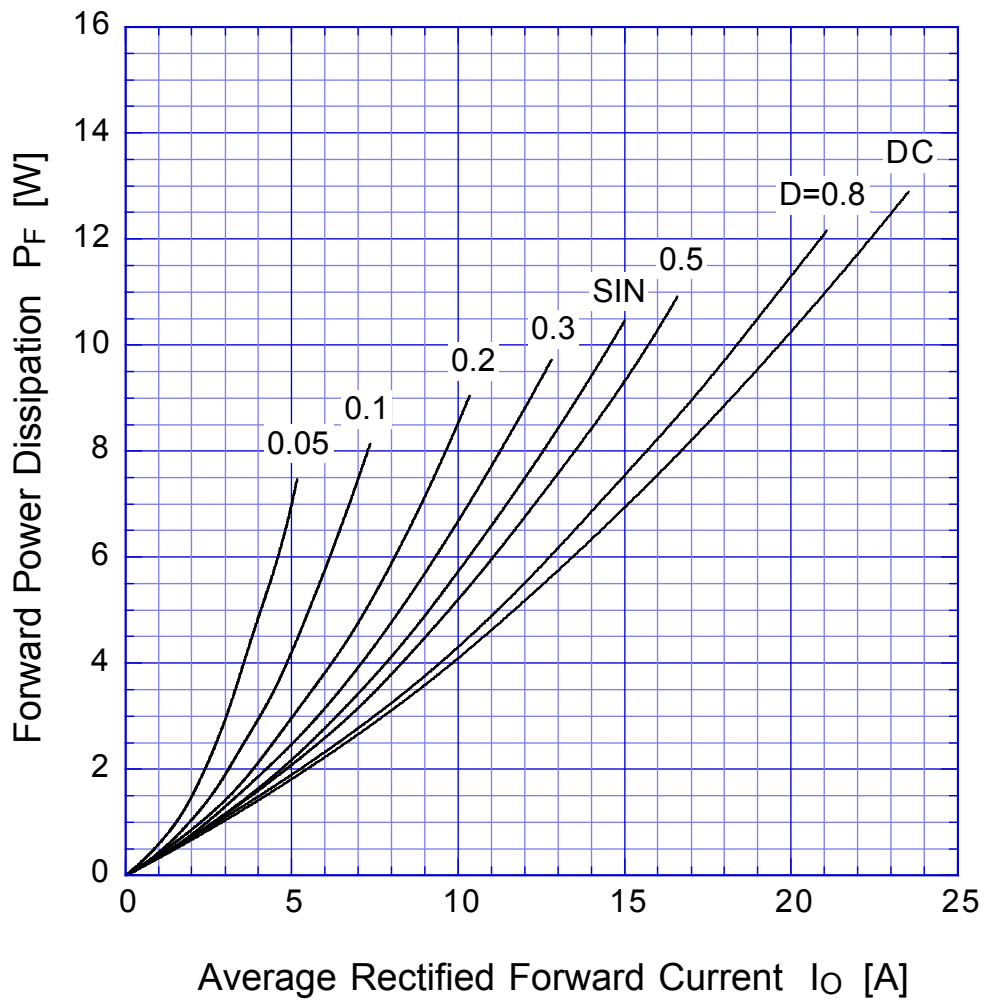
S15SCA4M Reverse Power Dissipation



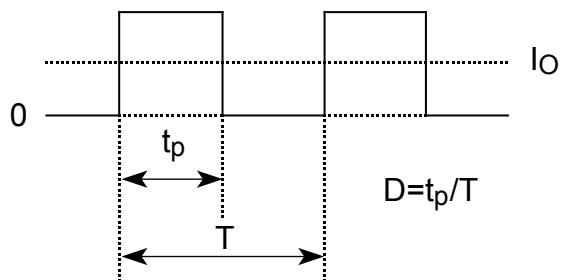

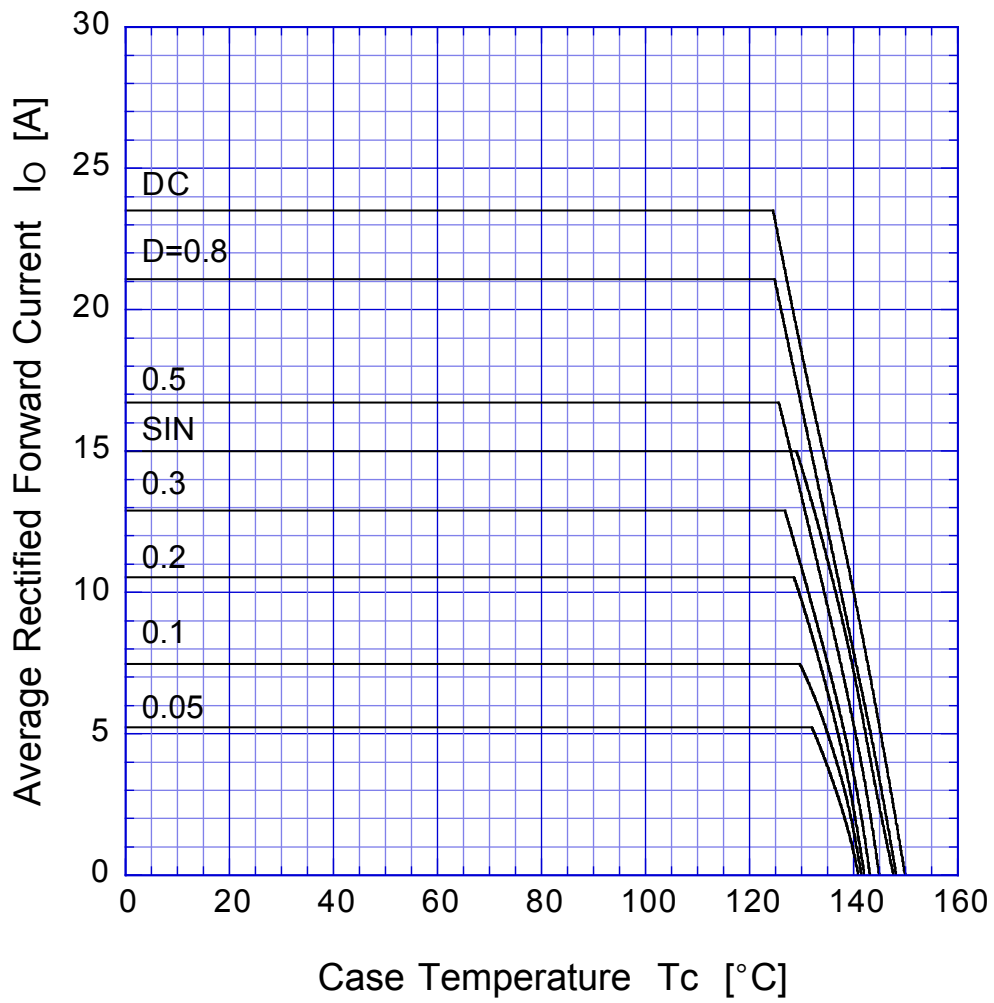

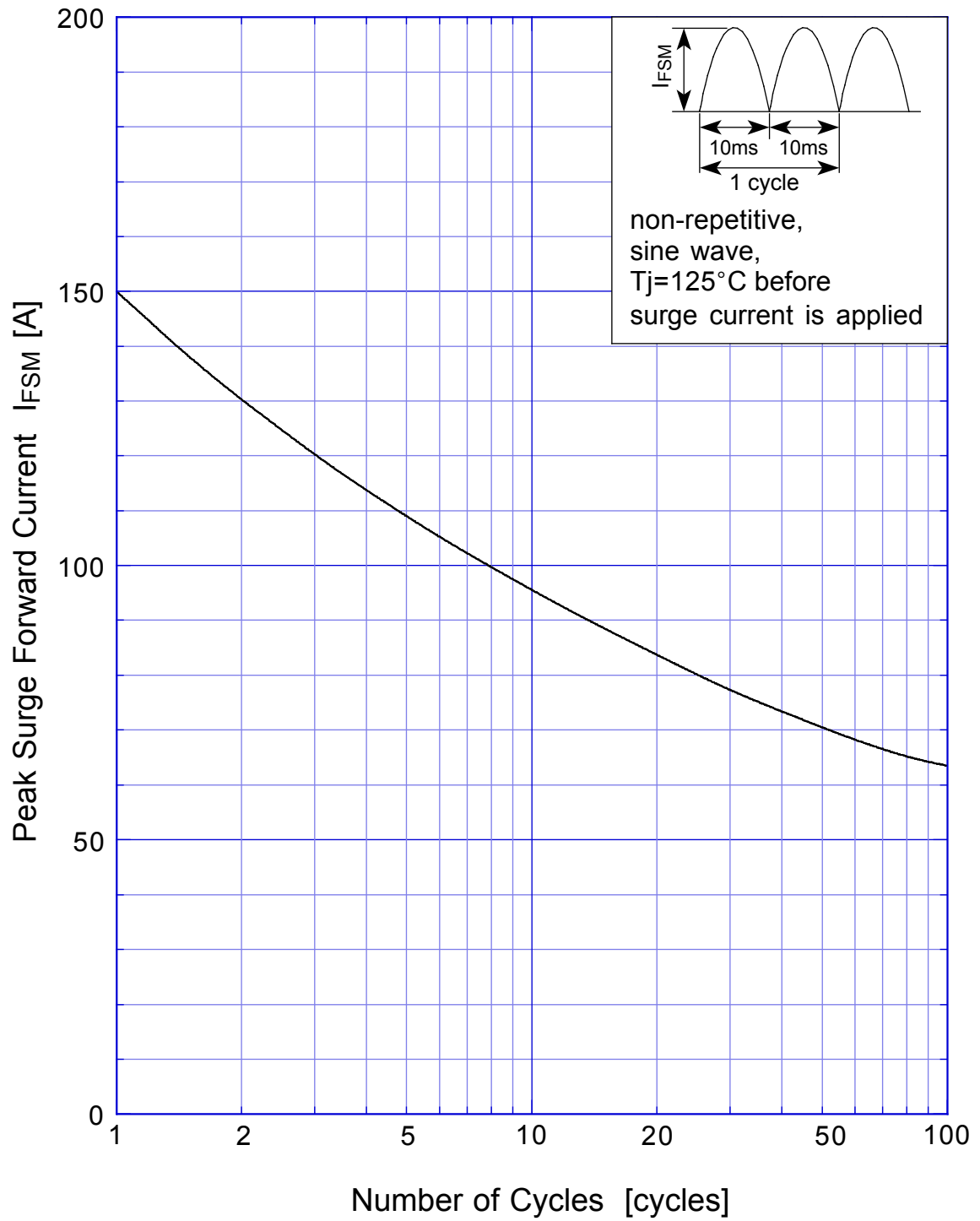
Derating Curve



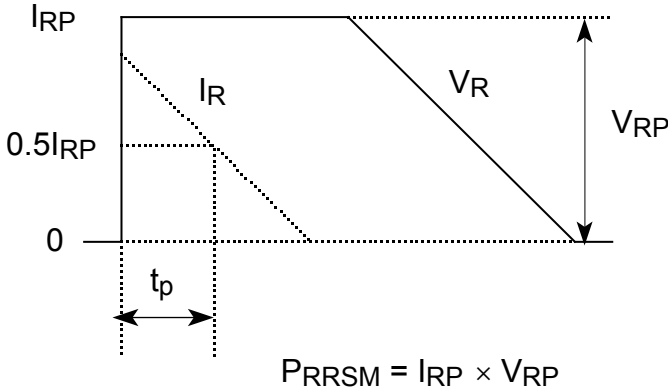
$V_R = 20V$
