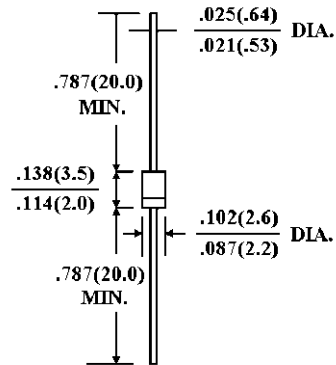

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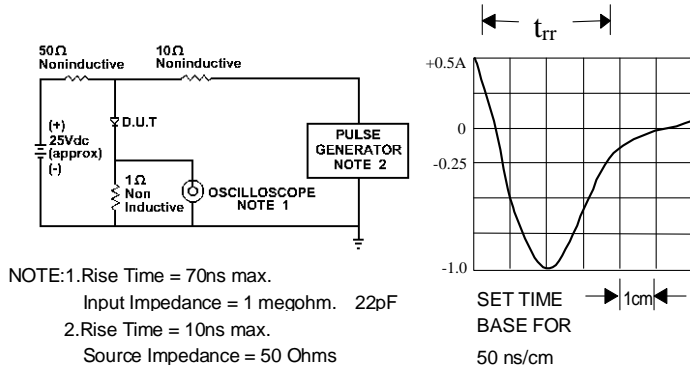


Fig. 1-REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC AND TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM

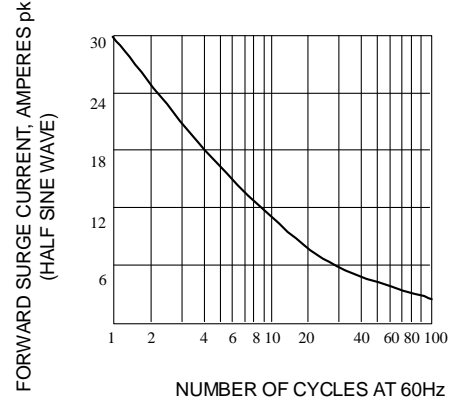


Fig. 2-MAXIMUM NON-REPEITIVE SURGE CURRENT

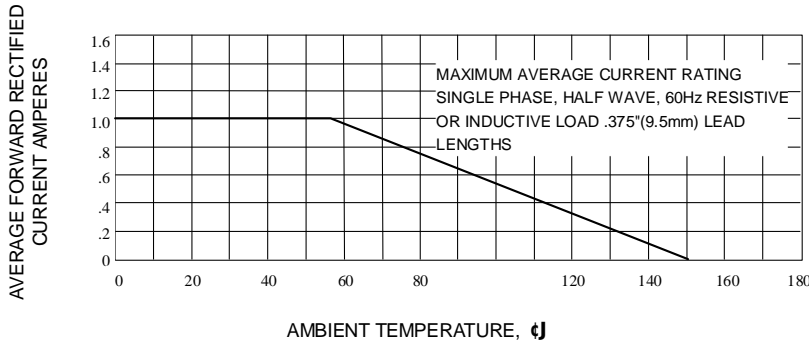


Fig. 3-MAXIMUM AVERAGE FORWARD CURRENT RATING

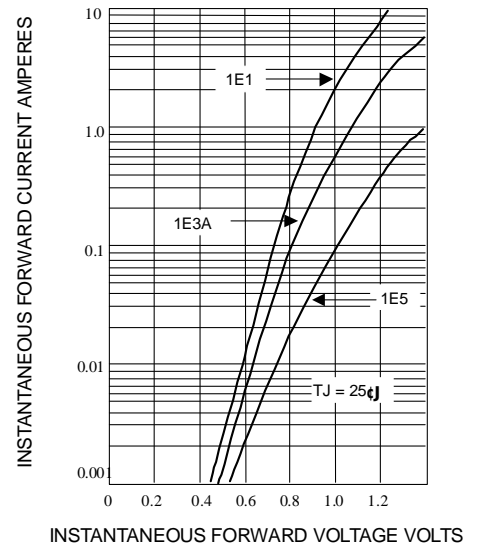


Fig. 4-FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

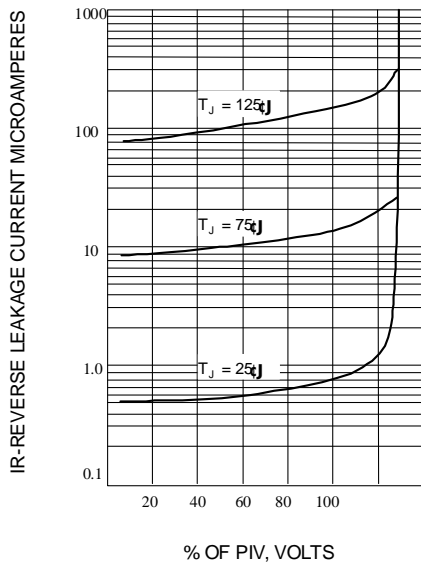


Fig. 5-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

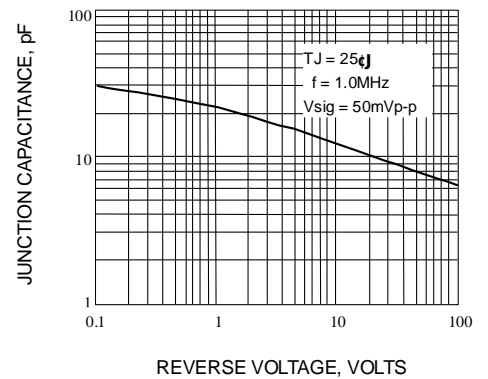


Fig. 6-TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE
