



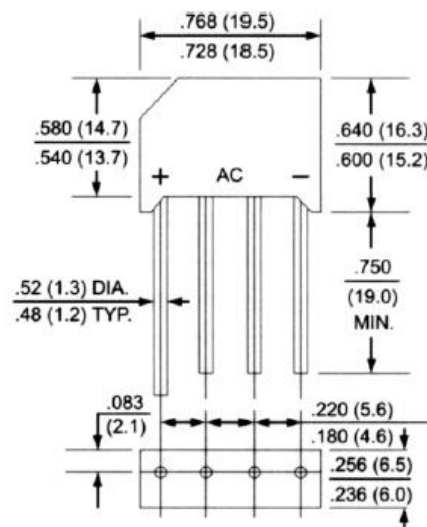

FIG. 1 - MAXIMUM FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

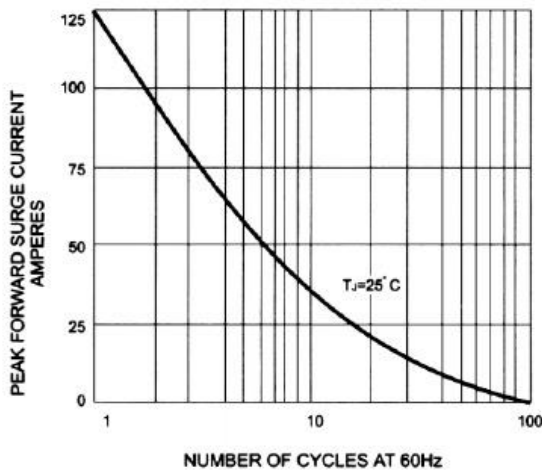


FIG. 2 - DERATING CURVE  
OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT

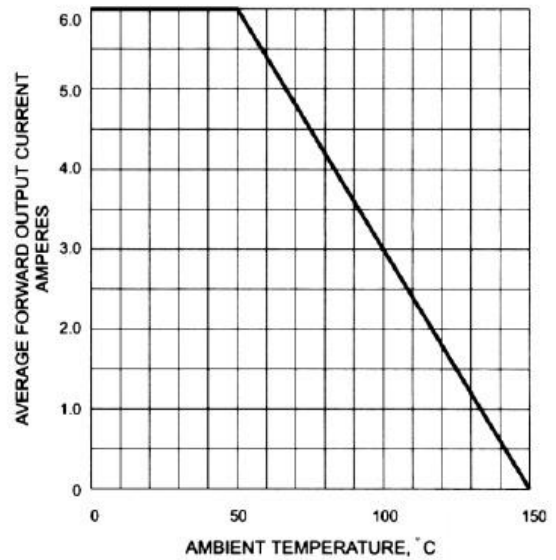


FIG. 3 - TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

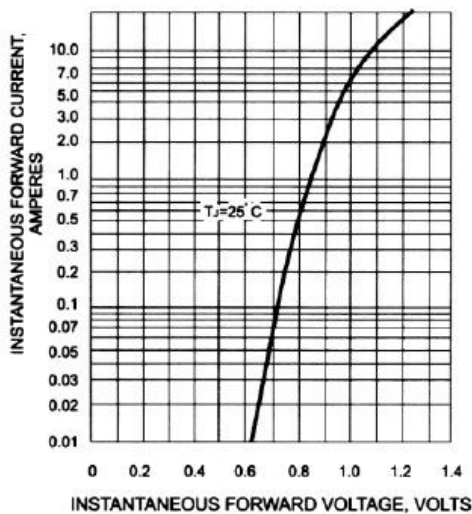


FIG. 4 - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
